JOB DESCRIPTION

Registered Dietitian/Nutritionist:

SCOPE OF DUTIES: *Under the supervision of the Program Manager of Southern California Alcohol & Drug Programs, the Registered Dietitian will promote healthy eating and nutrition, supervise the preparation and service of food, develop modified diets, participate in research, and educate individuals and groups on good nutritional habits. Registered dietitian will work with specific groups of people such as overweight individuals, those with medical problems such as diabetes or high blood pressure, pregnant women and children.*

- Collaborate with providers to identify and connect with patients in need of nutrition counseling
- Create individualized or group meal plans to ensure people obtain proper nutrition
- Educating patients on developing healthy preparation and eating habits
- Conducting group sessions
- Occasionally (hands on) assisting patients in kitchen
- Menu planning, and helping with the program food order
- Nutritional assessments, and conducting an educational group (once a week)
- Establish treatment plans and communicate with patients regarding program compliance
- Meet directly with patients to identify educational needs; provide individual instruction, utilize informational handouts/booklets, or refer to community resources as needed
- Identifies ways to improve care of patients, and make recommendations
- Perform research and recommend way to expand and improve nutrition programs
- Perform other duties and responsibilities as assigned
- Other tasks as assigned by the Program Manager

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelors degree in Nutrition or related field required
- Must have R.D. registration
- Certifies as a Diabetes Educator helpful
- Excellent oral and written communications skills
- Basic computer skills required
- Culturally competent/sensitive, with bi-lingual skills preferred
